ITEM 1 - Public Comments.

WHEREAS, congratulations and citations are in order for Ja'Deion High for representing the United States at the Flag Football World Championship in Finland and winning the gold medal which deserves special recognition by the governing body of this City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Cathy Bunch, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Hereford, Texas do hereby proclaim that the sincere appreciation of the City Commission, the City Administration, and all the citizens at large of this community, are hereby extended to Ja'Deion High for his remarkable accomplishments.
